



DARWIN WATERFRONT FASHIONS ON THE FIELD TERMS & CONDITIONS HEATS AND FINAL

In order to qualify for the Darwin Waterfront Fashions on the Field Final held at Fannie Bay Racecourse on Monday 7th August, individuals must compete and be successful in one of the nominated heats throughout the Carnival.

JUDGING CRITERIA

Contestants will be judged following the following criteria:

- Style and originality;
- Appropriateness of the outfit for the specific race day and the individual;
- Attention to detail with accessories;
- Understanding and interpretation of the current fashion trends / or understanding and interpretation of the Carnival of Colour theme; and
- Grooming and deportment.

ENTRY CONDITIONS

- By participating in either the Heats or Final, contestants agree to observe and be bound by these Terms & Conditions.
- The women's race wear category heats will consist of 6 events held at the Darwin Turf Club
 - Day 3 - Ladies Day Wednesday 19th July: x2 competitions (x1 on track and x1 in Schweppes Pavilion event)
 - Day 4 - Derby Day Saturday 22nd July: x1 competition on track
 - Day 7 - Sprint Day Saturday 5th August: x1 competition on track
 - Day 8 - Darwin Cup Day Monday 7th August: x2 competitions on track (Under 40, Over 40)
 - Final – Darwin Cup Monday 7th August
- Pre-registrations are limited to 20 places on Days 3, 4 and 7.
- Day 8 pre-registrations are limited to 60 people with pre-judging rounds held before successful nominations announced for the 20 entrants for the Under 40 and Over 40 category heats.
- By nominating for Darwin Waterfront Fashions on the Field you consent to having your photo/video taken to be used/broadcast by attending media, the Darwin Turf Club and by Victoria Racing Club Limited for marketing and promotional purposes.
- DTC will advise the Finalists of competition judging times and finalists who fail to appear at the correct time will be disqualified from the final and their entry deemed invalid.
- The judges will determine the winners of the 2017 Darwin Waterfront Fashions on the Field heats and final in accordance with the judging criteria.
- The winner of each minor competition pre Cup Day will progress to the final on Carlton Mid Darwin Cup Day on Day 8.

- On Day 8 Darwin Cup Day, two finalists from the Under 40 and Over 40 female categories will progress to the grand final held later that day.
- 8 female finalists in total will compete in the Grand Final with a winner and runner up being announced by the panel of judges.

HOW TO ENTER

- In order to qualify for the Fashions on the Field Final, contestants must compete and be successful at one of the nominated Heats.
- To enter one of the heats you must register on the day at the Fashions on the Field area by completing the entry form provided during the registration period.
- Contestants may enter once per heat provided that:
 - A contestant may not compete in the same outfit for each heat (to avoid doubt, an outfit worn in one heat and altered for a second heat will be disqualified)
 - A contestant has not already won a heat
- No responsibility will be taken to incomplete, late or lost entries or if the contestant is late to register.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to participate in the Fashions on the Field competition, contestants must acknowledge and agree to the following contestant criteria (Contestant Criteria):

- Contestants must be 18 years of age or older.
- Contestants and/or their outfits must not promote commercially a brand, store or designer or receive a commercial benefit from appearing in the competition.
- Contestants must not alter or add to their outfit in any way from the beginning until the end of the Competition. (Including Heats and Finals)
- Entry may be refused if a Contestant does not meet one or more of the Contestant Criteria listed.
- DTC reserves the right to verify the validity of any entries and reserves the right to disqualify any entrant who supplies invalid information that is not in accordance with these Terms & Conditions.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- The judging panel's decision is final.
- In the event of a draw at the Heat and or Final, the head judge will determine the winner.

HEAT PROCESS

- The 2017 Darwin Waterfront Fashions on the Field Heats will be conducted over four race meetings.
- A contestant who wins a heat is not eligible to qualify at any other heat throughout the series.

- A contestant who wins a Heat and qualifies for the Final may make further alterations or additions to their outfit or create an entirely new outfit for the Final.
- The winner of each Heat will receive a Darwin Waterfront prize pack valued at \$200 and a Carnival pass valued at \$99. Total prize value \$299
- The runner up of each heat will each receive a \$100 Darwin Waterfront prize pack and a Carnival pass valued at \$99. Total prize value \$199.
- Two contestants from the Under 40 heat and the Over 40 heat on Darwin Cup Day will go through to the Grand Final in no particular order.
- The winner of each Heat will be required to attend Cup Day on Monday 7th August to compete in the Grand Final.

FINAL PROCESS

- The Heat winners will compete in the 2017 Darwin Waterfront Fashions on the Field Grand Final on Monday 7th August 2017.
- The finalists will consist of eight valid winners from the heats conducted throughout the Carnival.

WINNERS & COMPETITION PRIZES

- Prize suppliers will not be liable for any loss or damage whatsoever which is suffered (including but not limited to indirect or consequential loss) in connection with this competition, including for personal injury suffered or sustained as a result of receiving or using a prize, except for any liability which cannot be excluded by law (in which case that liability is limited to the minimum allowable by law).
- Darwin Turf Club will provide the following:
 - A Darwin Waterfront prize pack and a Carnival pass for each heat winner and runner up.
 - The overall winner will receive one return economy airfare to Melbourne, and two nights accommodation (venue TBC).
- The Victoria Racing Club will provide the following prize to the winner of 2017 Darwin Waterfront Fashions on the Field competition:
 - Two (2) General Admission tickets to the 2017 Emirates Melbourne Cup
 - Two (2) wristbands into the 2017 Myer Fashions on the Field enclosure
 - The opportunity to enter the Preliminary Finals on Emirates Melbourne Cup Day

PHOTOGRAPHS & PERSONAL DETAILS

- The DTC collects personal information from the contestants in order to facilitate the promotion. Contestant's personal information may also be provided to third parties (including prize suppliers) for the purpose of administering this Promotion or providing prizes.

- All entries will be entered into the DTC database and the contestant agrees to have “opted in” and the DTC can use their details for future promotional, marketing and publicity purposes, including keeping the entrant informed of the latest DTC events.
- Contestants authorise and grant DTC the right to: Record their image, voice and performance during the 2017 Darwin Waterfront Fashions on the Field Competition including photographs, film and other audio visual materials and the right to copy, adapt, edit, alter, reproduce, publish, distribute, broadcast, transmit parts or all of the materials recorded of the Contestant for the purpose of publicity and promotion of DTC.

GENERAL

- All entries become the property of the DTC once submitted
- At the time of publishing all information was correct.
- Additional prizes may be added to the prize pools as and when the opportunity arises.
- If, for any reason the competition or any of its prizes are not capable of being run or offered as planned, the DTC reserves the right in its absolute discretion to take any action that may be available. If the competition is not capable of being run, the DTC will not be liable for any loss or damage of any kind.
- The Promoter at its absolute discretion, may prohibit or disqualify a Contestant from participating in the 2017 Darwin Waterfront Fashions on the Field Competition at any time (including any Heat or Final), cancel or suspend a prize or cease to provide a prize to a winner, if the DTC is made aware that the Contestant (at any time before or during any Heat or Final) are in the reasonable opinion of the DTC

 - Engaging in conduct that is misleading or deceptive
 - Engaging in any other conduct or manner which might reasonably be expected to affect the image or reputation of the DTC, its Sponsors or their respective events, goods or services.
